Albert William Law, our dearly loved father, grandfather, great grandfather, and great, great grandfather quietly passed away on Sunday evening, March 11, 2012, into the arms of waiting loved ones.

He was born in Bountiful, Utah on September 18, 1919 to Samuel Charles William Law and Rachel Harrietta Sedgwick. He grew up in Bountiful, graduated from Davis High and attended Utah State University before serving a full time mission to the Central States Mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints. He married our dear mother, Vinone Sutcliffe, in the Salt Lake Temple on April 28, 1944. They were married at the height of World War II, just before Dad shipped out for basic training in the Navy where he served honorably.

He became a master carpenter. He built his own home and helped many other family members and neighbors build and remodel their homes. He loved to work with wood. Some of the things he made will be family treasures for generations.

His life was given in service, mostly to his family, his neighbors and the Church. He served in many callings. Even though he was quiet and reserved, he loved missionary work, serving as a

young man and then with his eternal companion in San Diego, where they were able to work with the young sailors at the naval base.

After mother's passing in 1991, he married Merle H. Dow. They were able to travel and do many things together before her passing.
