Rose Eliza Trinnaman Laveder passed away surrounded by her family at the age of 94 on January 4, 2011 due to complications from a stroke.

She was born August 16, 1916 in Lehi, Utah to Thomas George and Sarah Ethel Thornton Trinnaman. Rose grew up on her family's farm in the then small town of Lehi and spent her days playing in the fields and trees around her home and in American Fork Canyon. She graduated from Lehi High School.
