Carol Peterson Ware, 89, peacefully passed from this life on Monday, May 16, while staying in the home of Kent and Lora Lee Dastrup in Centerville, Utah. She leaves behind many who love her and moves to a spiritual life with countless others who affectionately welcome her home.

She was born December 8, 1926 in Richfield, Utah to John Lester Peterson and Ellen Rosina Oldroyd Peterson. Carol's mother passed away just over a month after her birth.
